## **Educational Outcomes for Vulnerable Children**

The Centre for Excellence in Child and Family Welfare is working on a project to improve educational outcomes for children and young people in care. They are keen to hear from carers (permanent and kinship) about your child's engagement in education and what helps them stay connected to school.

They want to know:

- What has been helpful for keeping kids engaged in education?
- What are the challenges in keeping them engaged?
- What support (information, resources, other support) would help your children stay engaged in education?

The insights you provide will help them develop some useful resources to help carers support children in staying engaged in school.

They welcome feedback by any means – phone call, video chat, email or group discussions/forums.

## **News - Flexi Funding Tips**

We understand this is a stressful time for many and that we can help by processing your Flexible Funding Applications as quickly as possible. To help with this aim, here are some tips:



- 1. We aim to process applications within 21 days. Currently we are experiencing a high number of applications. Please do not call us to check on the status of your application until after 28 days, as this takes away time from processing the applications.
- 2. We have limited funding. Your application must meet the guidelines we have agreed with the Department of Families, Fairness and Housing, and we must be fair to all eligible applicants. You may not receive everything you ask for. What we can and cannot fund is on our website (eg we cannot fund items covered by other funding sources such as the DFFH care allowance). We also consider how much funding you have already received.
- 3. To avoid being asked to provide further information to help us assess your application, please provide supporting documentation with your application as to why the services (eg camps, counselling, animal therapy etc) are in the best interests of your child and how they are trauma informed services that provide the most benefit for your child.
  This might be a letter from a supporting professional, educator or the service provider.
- 4. Please prioritise the items you are seeking funding for. The more items on an application the longer it takes us to process.
- 5. We prioritise processing of applications for those who have not previously received funding and otherwise in the order they are received to be fair to all. If you believe there is an urgent need for funding then you must provide supporting documentation from a professional as to why this is the case.

Please make sure all your interactions with our staff are positive and respectful.

#### Flexi-Funds

A reminder that PCA Families has Flexible Funding available to meet the extraordinary needs of children and young people subject to a Permanent Care Order, or where you are receiving DFFH care allowance and have a Family Court Order or Special Needs Adoption Order.

Flexi funds can be used for therapeutic, educational and medical services, to build skills, interests or attachment, to elevate family contact and cultural identity, to offer respite, home medication or other services like whitegoods, one off clothing, estate planning or vehicle needs eg car seats.
