Same Sex Parenting - from respite care to permanent care with gratitude and connection.



David and Michael are a same sex couple who formed their family after a long term respite care (foster care) relationship developed into a permanent care placement.

Their two children, two brothers, were 2 and 3.5 years old when they would come for respite care from Friday night to Sunday night every second weekend.

Those two children became a permanent part of David and Michael's lives and are now young adults.

We have a wealth of information to learn from David and Michael about gratitude, how a strong emotional connection can lead to great things and how to navigate care in the LBGQTI and broader community with keeping expectations high.

News - Get Active

Last week we mentioned that the State Government is offering pensioners and health care card holders access to reimbursements for sport and recreation activities for 4 to 18 year olds. We should have also mentioned that all permanent carers and adoptive parents are also eligible by emailing getactivekids@sport.vic.gov.au to advise you are in receipt of DFFH allowance (provide childs name and order number / details). 28 July - NDIS - shared experiences and tips


11 August - Life Story - how much to share and with who?

A reminder that PCA Families has Flexible Funding available to meet the extraordinary needs of children and young people subject to a Permanent Care Order, or where you are receiving DFFH care allowance and have a Family Court Order or Special Needs Adoption Order. Flexi funds can be used for therapeutic, educational and medical services, to build skills, interests or attachment, to elevate family contact and cultural identity, to offer respite, home medication or other services like whitegoods, one off clothing, estate planning or vehicle needs eg car seats.
